
We are reeling from the devastating events playing out in Ukraine and our love and sympathy goes out to everyone impacted.

Cycle Alton are offering FREE cycle training courses

on Saturday 19th March in Amery Hill School playground at 10am and 1pm. Each session is limited to five participants so early booking is recommended by emailing <u>cyclealton@gmail.com</u> or ringing Chris on 07815 670191.

Training is offered at two different skill levels: those who need basic bicycle handling skills and will remain in the playground, and those who want to gain confidence and will be taken out on local roads by the instructor. Time is running out to access this grant scheme - deadline 31st March

Alton residents could qualify for free energy saving measures, through the government's Green Homes Grant scheme. You could qualify if your home is hard to heat, owned or privately rented, and you are in receipt of benefits or on a low income.

What can be funded by the scheme?

The scheme can fund a range of energy efficiency measures including:

- Wall insulation
- Loft insulation
- Renewable heating systems (such as air source heat pumps)
- Double/triple glazing (to replace single glazing)
- Energy efficient doors
- Thermostats and heating controls

Warmworks has been appointed as the Managing Agent for this Green Homes Grant scheme.

Warmworks will, free of charge:

- Assess your property
- Check to see if you meet the criteria
- Provide you with a report, recommending improvements for your home
- Access the funding on your behalf
- Arrange the installation of the improvements
- Carry out a quality inspection of the work

If you'd like to take advantage of this funding, then get in touch with <u>Warmworks</u> and they'll talk you through the process.

This round of funding will end on 31 March 2022 and installation should take place before the end of June 2022.
