Understanding the impact of climate change through a <u>'Climate Mosaik' Workshop</u>

On 29th March ACAN's Eco Streets programme hosted an enlightening interactive workshop to help participants gain a deeper understanding of how climate change affects our world, and how it's causes and effects are interlinked.

The session let by Scott Gudrich developed a "Climate Mosaik" perspective and gave it a title: *"Our Survival or Pathway to Disaster"*.



Explore the South Downs National Park with Eco Streets

We are excited to launch the newest project within Eco Streets. Through guided walks and creative interactions with the environment, we want to help create a deeper connection with the South Downs National Park (SDNP) among residents of Alton.

Focused on the western edge of Alton, but open to everyone, this community initiative is set to introduce residents to the wonders of the South Downs National Park and encourage them to start exploring it themselves. The project will provide a unique entry point into the park through a variety of imaginative guided walks and workshops.

Thanks to a grant by the SDNP and Alton Town councillors Ginny Boxall and Barbara Tansey, we will be able to offer 10 guided walks and 4 creative workshops which will all offer different insights and connection points to the National Park.

The first guided walk will take place on **Sunday 6th April at 12:00 midday**. We will meet at Chawton Car Park. The walk, which will last approximately 75 minutes, will be followed by an informal project launch celebration with coffee and cake at Cassandra's Cup.

This walk will take participants around Chawton, taking in the signs of spring. We will repeat this very walk in summer, autumn and winter to observe the changing seasons.

There is some free parking in Chawton but it does get very busy, so we would suggest you walk or cycle if possible. All walks and workshops are free to attend and open to all.
